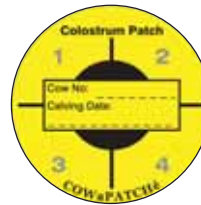

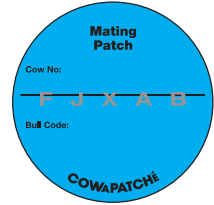

FACT SHEET # 12 COWPATCHÉ



PRODUCT INFORMATION

COWaPATCHé is a highly simple and accurate herd health management system, which incorporates a sticky identification sticker to provide farmers with all the information they require for each cow. A permanent marker is used to record the required information on the patch, which is attached by simply spraying the cow's backside and then firmly placing the patch on the sprayed area. The patches can stay on for up to three months and are weather resilient. Removal of the patch is simple, gently roll the patch down and dispose.

There are seven patch options available:

Treatment patch - Whether it's a hoof or udder complaint, front or rear - left or right, fill in the treatment details. This patch is designed to have the information right in front of you.

Observation patch - This patch is designed to bring to your attention any rising health issues. This encourages staff to follow up for assessment - treatment or vetting.

Colostrum patch - For factory supply this patch helps you manage the optimum strength of colostrum. This patch also manages a cow's readiness for milk collection to the vat.

Dry Cow Therapy patch - For the end of season - drying off. Why risk freshly treated cows jumping the fence to rejoin their mates in the herd. This identifies cows that have been treated.

Return to Vat patch - Simply record the latest treatment date and then observe and calculate the withholding periods for a safe return to the milking herd/vat.

Meat Withholding patch - Any cows having serious drugs that have an excess 30 days withholding may require this patch, especially those cows that are having a rough time healthwise.

Mating patch - I.D the cows on heat, record on the patch your preferred sire, the A.I technician will take over. Follow up the next day with the reapplication of your heat detection system.
