Water Nipple Calf Drinking

We know this is unusual for New Zealand and Australia, but your calves will have no trouble at all working out how to get a drink from this new water nipple. Just pipe directly into your calf pens. Ideally use a 45° mounting bracket facing downwards (see our Water Nipple Bracket in Pig Breeding section) and mount at an appropriate height for your calves to drink comfortably (probably about 70cm for young calves). Ensure the spring-plate is at the top. Biting action of the calf operates the water valve. Water flow is adjustable, but nipple is best used in medium to high pressure systems. All stainless steel bite parts. Brass mounting part. Filter incorporated. This nipple is self-cleaning with patented flush action after each use. Time to ditch those old contaminated troughs. Length 10cm o.a.



Hay Rack Folding

This hay rack is ideal for setting up in temporary pens or paddocks for feeding small amounts of hay, or for taking to shows etc. Easy to transport, set up and take down. Easily stored away when not required. Sides fold in flat. Just hang or tie it on any convenient fence or wall. 60cm square, made out of 6mm steel rod, galvanised finish. Most suitable for smaller livestock.



Meal Starter Bottle

No waste or mess. Feed is always clean and dry. Supplied complete with screw-on plastic mounting bracket. Optional extra, strong steel bracket available, especially for use by large strong calves. Bottle capacity 4 litres.

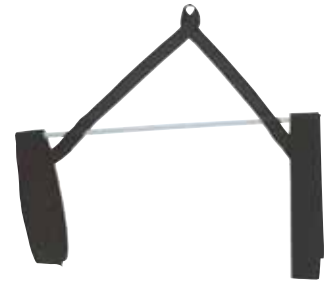
NB: Teat slit should be vertical for correct operation. Teats also fit Braden bottles. Secure plastic bracket to rail before attempting to attach feeder to it. We recommend use of optional steel mounting bracket.
