Barnes dehorners offer a simple dehorning solution for calves up to about 15 months old. They are a low-cost tool used to scoop out the whole horn bud, ideally also with a ring of hair at the base to ensure prevention of regrowth. Use 32cm tool for calves up to eight months, and 42cm tool for calves up to 15 months. Our economy dehorners are quite adequate for the task, but the quality versions are from Stone Mfg, USA, and feature concentric jaws which cut cleanly all around, without clashing. The quality tools also feature Rockwell 45-standard hardened jaws to retain their cutting edge for life. The stainless steel tool has the advantage of resistance to corrosion. Even the hinge rivet is stainless. Features as for quality range.



Wire Saw Bridge

One of the simplest tools we have, but very effective. Particularly useful for the owner or vet having occasional stock to dehorn. This 50cm long, all stainless steel bridge, can be used with dehorning wire handles (as below), calving chain handles, or any other convenient handle. This accomplishes a quick and efficient dehorning job on larger horns, but be sure to follow all usual dehorning rules and staunch bleeding.



Wire Saw Kruse

Dehorning wire has been used for many years for removing mature or semi mature horns. This special wire is made of steel with saw teeth. A short piece is locked into the special handles and then simply used as a saw around the horn base, as close to the skull as possible. Change wire after 2 or 3 horns. Use hot iron or Dehorning Packing to stop bleeding. Allow animal to stand quietly afterwards. Do not mix immediately with other stock. Also useful for de-tusking boars.



Yearling Electro-tek Stainless

The Electro-tek dehorner is one of the nicest made we have. Very lightweight and a smooth cutting action with the quadrant-link mechanism. The head assembly is all in cast stainless steel, very strong and reliable. Cupped blades opening to 55mm. Hardwood handles 28cm long. Length 56cm o.a. Weight 2.8kg.



Yearling Shoof Stainless

All stainless steel medium-size dehorner suitable cattle up to about 18 months. Quadrant blade-links mechanism for easy cutting action. Cupped blades opening to 55mm. Length 60cm o.a. Weight 2.7kg.

From Argentina, these dehorners are very robust. Sizes for use on stock from 6-18 months. Geared quadrants good for lighter cutting jobs. Cupped blades opening 45mm on smallest and 50mm on larger sizes. Steel handles. Chrome plated for easier cleaning. Dimensions listed are length overall. 68cm and 78cm models use same size head and blades.



Packing Keystone

From Keystone Dehorner in USA. Prevent blood loss by using this simple packing. Apply packing immediately after dehorning and leave in place. The packing eventually falls off with the scab. Also useful to keep flies and germs out of horn wounds. Packing is made of all-natural fibre material. Pack is enough for approx 25 horns.

ANIMAL WELFARE CODE REQUIREMENT

We recommend the large Convex up to mature stock, but where horns are not at maximum growth. The 'parrot beak' jaw can be easier to use than the Keystone style, and the tool is more robust. Maximum blade opening 63mm. Replacement blade available. Handles 70cm long. Length 104cm o.a. Weight 7.5kg.
