The Chin-Ball Mating Harness was developed in New Zealand, and is used around the world for identifying mated cattle, or for marking cows empty or to be mated. The robust harness - halter has a cone shaped device underneath which contains a freely rotating ball, working on the same principle as a ball-pen.

The stainless steel ball container can be filled with ink of the desired colour. Each fill is enough to mark 25-30 cows (approx. 0.5 litre). When a cow is properly in season she will receive very clearly identifiable back markings from the bull (or cow) wearing the device. Marks fade in 4 to 14 days. We suggest changing colours on a 3 week cycle, to prevent any confusion. Ink is available in 1 litre containers.

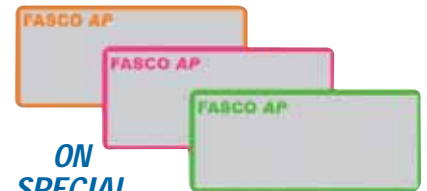

FASCO AP oestrus detectors are very easy to use. Simply peel the detector off the backing sheet and apply to the animal's tail bone. If the tail-bone hair is long, or wet, it should firstly be clipped, and then wiped with a cotton cloth. (Dipping the cloth in alcohol will assist cleaning the area.) As long as the detection label is properly applied, it will stay in place for several weeks, regardless of the weather. When a detector-applied animal is ridden in standing heat, the silver surface of the detector is rubbed off exposing the fluorescent-colour label. This is highly visible, even in low-light conditions. For best application, the detectors should be kept warm immediately prior to use. Body heat is ideal, so store in your clothing in colder weather. The warmer temperature better activates the label adhesive. Detectors are supplied in packs of 50 only.
