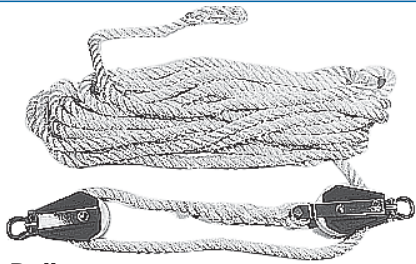

The 2-Pulley calf puller is a quality professional vet product from Denmark. The pulleys are high-impact plastic and stainless steel, and the set comes with 10m of easy to grip 10mm poly-rope. This device is made without a release-lock system, in line with European animal welfare concerns, as it allows the user to apply and release tension in sequence with the cow's contractions. Release-lock devices are not recommended for welfare-aware users. The Two-Pulley calf puller is easy to carry and store, and gives very adequate pulling power within humane limits. This puller requires the use of obstetric chains or ropes which must be purchased separately.

Although this 3-pulley system is useful for many pulling or lifting jobs, one of its most popular uses is as a calf puller. Attach the single block to an anchor point not more than two metres from the calf, then using calving chains or ropes on the calf's legs, connect the double-pulley block to the calf. The rope lock and release mechanism on the double-block is then easily and conveniently operated at the same time as checking the birth is progressing correctly. The Fast-Lock pulley system uses 7.2m of 10mm polyrope.

WARNING ABOUT CALVING CHAINS

Calving chains should not be used with mechanical calf pullers, for the following reasons:

1. The chain links can do serious damage to the calf's leg.
 2. The chains may break under the excessive force sometimes applied.
- Use ropes only with mechanical calving aids.

Designed and manufactured by an Australian vet, these straps eliminate the leg damage and trauma to the calf commonly caused by traditional chains and ropes. They are ideal for use on your calf puller, or for manual use using hand-loop ends. The extra rings allow for different pulling lengths. Straps are 75cm long and will not break or wear.

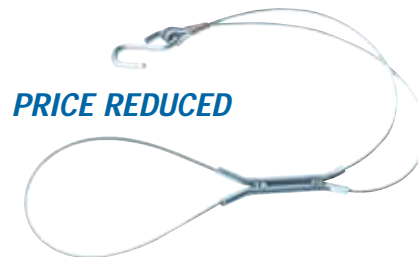

All stainless steel snare for assisting calving. Hook behind calf's ears to assist birthing in normal deliveries in conjunction with traction aids on legs. Use with care on calf's head and eyes, and ensure there is no strangulation. Can also be used as a leg snare in non-normal deliveries, to straighten legs. Length 75cm o.a.

Very useful device for difficult calvings. Enables traction on head, or just prevention of head turning back during the delivery. Stainless steel cable with cast alloy sliding yolk. Can be dismantled for cleaning. Length 92cm o.a.

Thinsulate® is an insulation product from 3M recommended for mountaineering and other extreme outdoor pursuits. It is quoted as 'one-and-a-half times warmer than down', and is effective even when damp or after repeated washings. The Thinsulate insulation is sandwiched between a quilted nylon inner and a hard-wearing Cordura® DuPont outer. Cordura resists wear and tear, and is polyurethane coated to be water resistant. The combination of the above materials makes the Thinsulate calf coat ideal for therapeutic use in trauma recovery of a weakened calf, or to protect weak or sickly calves in cold weather. Dimension listed above is the length of the calf's body, from brisket (under neck) to back of legs, that the coat is made for.



Cow Cover Thermal Emergency

These covers have been produced especially for cases of thermal emergency in dairy cows, for example after traumatic calving, accident or injury, etc. The cover external is made of heavy duty rip-stop cotton-canvas which allows breathability, thus reducing internal moisture build-up, at the same time as being highly waterproof. Internally the cover has 6mm of woven polyester covered with a smooth and hard wearing lining material. This combination gives excellent heat retention for the cow, ensuring body heat recovery in a short time.

NB: This is a cover for therapeutic emergency use, and should be used with caution on an animal with normal body temperature.

THERAPEUTIC USE

It should be noted that these calf and cow covers are designed for therapeutic use rather than everyday wear. As over-heating can also be a problem for animals, the covers should be changed for standard 'canvas' type covers once recovery of body temperature is achieved, or weather becomes warm.
