A different shape hoof knife used for planing off flat areas of over-grown hoof, without skinning your knuckles.



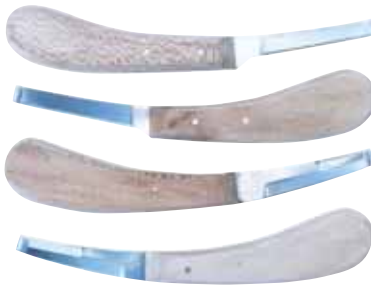
