Dairymen have always wanted a simple way to write some information on the back of a cow. We now have it. Cow Patches were developed in New Zealand by Wellsford dairy farmer Stuart Paterson. Stuart's answer was an adhesive-backed patch that sticks 100%-secure on an adhesive-sprayed patch on the cow.

Required details are written on the patch with a permanent-marker pen. Give the spot a quick squirt of adhesive spray. (If the cow is wet or dirty, just wipe off with a coarse kitchen-type scourer-sponge.) Peel the backing paper off the patch and apply to the hide.

Cow Patches applied in this way do not fall off, regardless of conditions. Updates to patch information can be made directly on the cow. When removal is required get your fingers under the patch edge and pull firmly (This may also pull out some hair, but no harm is done). If left on the cow, patches will stay in place for many months. Patches are supplied only in 20-pack boxes of each type. The Cow Patch system will work equally well with other types of contact adhesive, although aerosols are the most convenient to use. Patches are 8cm diameter.

The Cow Patch Dispenser Kit includes 20 of each 'Colostrum' and 'Treatment' patches, 210ml adhesive can, and a marking pen, all in a handy perspex dispenser. The dispenser has tie-strap slots strategically placed to allow easy mounting on a vertical support pipe. (Ties provided). Each patch cavity has a space for up to 35 patches. Patch stacks can be changed to suit the season, or mixed to suit demand. (Colours are still visible.) The dispenser is 53cm tall, and 9cm square.

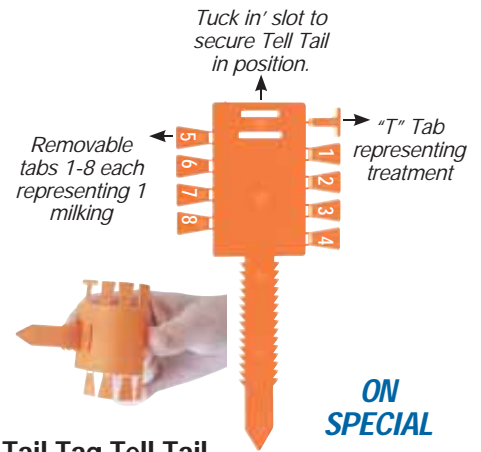

### Tail Tag Tell Tail

Another good simple way to keep track of the days for milk withholding periods. Firstly the milker must establish correctly the number of milkings to be withheld. The Tell Tail tag or tags should then have tabs removed to leave in place just the number for the required milkings following the treatment. Apply the tag (or tags) to the cow's tail, and remove the "T" tab after completing treatment. Then remove a tab at each subsequent milking. When the last tab comes off, remove the Tell Tail.
