Milk Train 4-place

Another great new feeder from the makers of the Milk Train calf feeder is the new Milk Train for lambs, and kids. This four-place feeder uses the Excal Little Softy no-leak teats with Excal intake elbow/valves. Total capacity is 4 litres (with splash space to spare) with individual chambers of 750ml each. These feeders join together to make an 8 or 12 place feeder as required, and also nest with teats on, for convenient movement and storage. Replaceable rail-hooks secure the feeder to most pipe or wood rails up to 38mm thick. A wall bracket is also available.



M1 Rail-hang 'Ad-Lib'

This single-place lamb feeder is being used in a novel way. Use with cold milk as an ad-lib feeder. The cold milk limits over-feeding, and also keeps longer. In fact, to assist, drop an Esky cold pack, or a small frozen bottle of water in the milk. Remember to cover the feeder with something to keep flies out. The black Excal 'Regular' teat is not recommended for new-borns, but it will last longer with stronger animals feeding ad-lib. Capacity 5 litres. Stainless steel lid available separately.



Neck Bands Temporary ID

Strong plastic-backed waterproof fabric bands with self-adhesive tab. Can be written on with a waterproof marking pen to give reliable identification especially for patients of vet clinics, or clients of boarding facilities, etc. Also useful for tagging new-born lambs, kids, puppies, etc. Bands are 30cm long, and can be cut to required length.



Bucket Pull-through Teats

Big easy-to-fill bucket simply slips down over a suitable rail (see diagrams below for alternatives) to be secure. Six pull-through teats (three each side) of a soft, natural rubber. Teats incorporate a plastic non-return valve to reduce blow-back and assist feeding of weak lambs. Bucket capacity 11 litres.



Bucket Screw-on Teats

Same bucket as our standard Lamb Feeder bucket, but this one features screw-on type teat assemblies. These are easily and quickly removed for cleaning, or to replace teats. The teat mount incorporates a non-return valve, and also an internal intake tube to the bottom of the bucket to minimise wastage. Latex teats are better for starting new lambs, but rubber replacement teats will last much longer. Bucket capacity 11 litres.



Bucket Excal Teats

Same as our other 6-space lamb feeding buckets, but incorporating our Excal 'Little Softy' no-leak lamb/kid teats complete with Excal intake elbow/valves. Bucket capacity 11 litre.



Station 5-place

A good strong easy-to-use lamb feeding station. Sturdy hooks on the back for hanging over a rail. The screw-on teats are easily replaced by removing the big plastic nut. No tools required. Five compartments of one litre each. Fill all, or only as many compartments as you have lambs to feed. Medicate one compartment if required for a sick animal. Easy to clean. Feeder is supplied with soft latex teats, but longer lasting rubber teats are also available as optional extras.

*Teat mount does not include teat or washer.

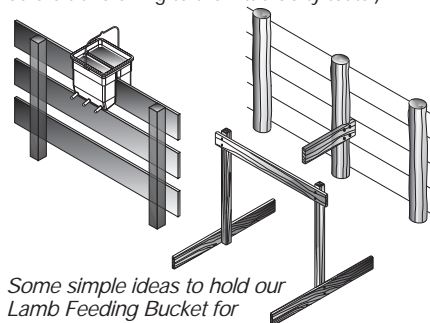
NB: Feeding Station can be retro-fitted with 'Bucket Screw-on' (204 207) mounts and teats to reduce replacement costs. But parts from each type can not be mixed.



Rail Bucket

Our 10-place lamb and kid feeding rail bucket is a big strong bucket with a 20 litre capacity. The teats are our own Excal 'Little Softy' complete with Excal intake elbow/valves, giving easy milk flow but without leaking, even when bucket is full. We have also included our Excal teat intake elbows with stop-valves. Rail hooks will suit any rail up to 40mm (1½") thick. (For new born lambs we recommend starting on a bottle for a few days before transferring to the Little Softy teats.)
